# Cup Winner Is Special

DYNA Tron threw his hat into the Brisbane Cup ring at Albion Park on Thursday night when doing just about everything wrong but still winning his heat in 30.04.

The son of Collision-Gold Rush Bale scored by five and a quarter lengths over Bogie King with two and a half lengths to CitiHawk in third. Dyna Tron, owned by Brendan Wheeler, was coming off his Group 1 Melbourne Cup victory at Sandown last week.

"Amazing," said handler George Dailly after Dyna Tron's victory. "He did everything wrong, but still won."

Dyna Tron did begin like a rocket and lead to the first turn through a 5.63 first section.

He led by eight lengths into the back straight but ran right off the track and his lead narrowed to three when he straightened up.

Bogie King made a race of it to the home turn where Dyna Tron again got off the track. He powered to the finish line though.

"This dog is a fantastic railer," said George. "How much will he improve next week."

Dyna Tron has won 20 of his 40 starts and George admitted it was only the past two months that the dog had improved out of sight to become a Group 1 performer.

"It was a nice time for him to do that," he said. "I can't believe how much he has improved in those two months."

Dyna Tron ran an 11.58 middle section and he weakened in the run to the line with a final section of 12.83, but he is certain to go much better in the final next week.

It was his first look at Albion Park.

The Brisbane Cup has had a few name changes when it was first run in 1972 and won by Victorian Garron Court the race was known as the Gabba Sprint Championship. It remain that name until 1976. It was then called the Brisbane Cup from 1977 until 1981 changed in 1982 to be known as the Coca-Cola Cup until 1999 when it changed back to the Brisbane Cup. The race was conducted at the Gabba until the track closed in 1992 and since has been staged at Albion Park.
