Talented Victorian sprinter Peter Rocket (\$5.10) won his way into the rich Sportingbet Group 1 Dapto Megastar with an impressive all the way victory in the Megastar Prelude on Thursday night. The Group 2 Horsham Cup winner starting for the first time at the tricky Dapto circuit begun okay from the outside draw, settled third at the first turn, he then chased early leader Mexico City (\$17.90) into the home straight grabbing the leader near the line for a solid win in 29.79. Mexico City for Mark Gatt joins Peter Rocket in the final and the fast finishing Amadeus Strikes, as usual came from nowhere to fill third spot and also take her place in the final next Friday night.

Two of the panel selected stars recorded outstanding trials between races on the night. Recent third placing in the National Sprint Zulu Zeus showed what a big motor he has with a fast solo effort of 29.46 a length inside Oh So Smooth's track record of 29.51. With sections of 5.45 and 17.08 he will prove hard to beat starting from box eight next week.

Grand campaigner Queensland superstar Glen Gallon maybe in the twilight of his career, however he has lost none of his pace. The winner of over \$600,000 in prizemoney trialed 29.57 with sections of 5.55 and 17.23 from the handy draw of three next week, there might just be another Group 1 in the champ. He finished unplaced last year.

Joining those two stars are multi Group 1 winner Proven Nitro beautifully draw in box one, Derby winner Jagger Swagger and four time Dapto winner with a best of 29.56 Double Twist, she rounds out the star studded line up and will jump from box four.

This is the fourth running of the Sportingbet Megastar first won in 2010 by Ron Ball's Mr. Metz then in 2011 the brilliant Oaks Road won for Mark Gatt, while last year's winner from box eight was Bye Bye Bucks for trainer Ken Lewis. With the talent engaged in this years event another top performer will be added to the honour roll.

Appears to be drawn okay and if he uses some early speed to take up a good position at the first turn you will want to be on him if he has clear ground down the back. Ready for a Group 1 win.
