"Gold Cup Final Full of Talent"

Blue Lorian is back again and with the Group 1 Albion Park Gold Cup final in his sights.

The grand campaigner, a son of Surf Lorian-Winsome Bluebird, led throughout to win his heat of the Cup on Thursday night in 41.96 scoring by two and a half lengths over Bobby Boucheau with a length and three-quarters to Pillow Torque in third.

Blue Lorian chased home Nellie Noodles and Dashing Corsair in last year's Gold Cup final when he was just a promising young stayer. Since then he has won the Group 1 National Distance and WA Galaxy and been in a host of Group staying races right around the country.

Owner-trainer Peter Whye sent the dog north to be handled by local trainer Tom Tzouvelis. He arrived on Wednesday and will head back to Young in NSW on Friday morning.

Whye could not come north with his champion stayer because he is moving home to Young. He is unlikely to be able to make it to Albion Park for the final.

Tzouvelis said he expects the dog to again be flown north next Wednesday for the rich final.

Blue Lorian has now won 32 races and been placed in 23 of his 67 starts.

He has been a wonderful galloper for Whye the first dog he has owned or trained. Peter's wife bought him the dog as a Christmas present.

Blue Lorian led throughout and then held off a late charge from Bobby Boucheau. The Sandown Cup winner Bobby Boucheau began poorly and was off the track around the first turn but he ran on strongly in the home straight and he is certain to be further improved for next week's final.

Pillow Torque was a handy run beginning well and being second early but she dropped back to fourth in the back straight. She finished on again towards the line to get third.

The late Bob Biddle would have been proud and he had every right to be.

Former Queenslander Bob died of cancer on Wednesday night. Bob's family bred Bramley (Big Daddy Cool-Abbadale Gold) who swept through his field to win a heat of the Group 1 Gold Cup (710m) at Albion Park on Thursday night.

He scored by three lengths over Shimaguni with two and a quarter lengths to Lady Arko in third. Trainer Troy Iwanyk was the least surprised by Bramley's victory.

"He's always gone under the radar," said Troy the former WA trainer now based in Victoria. "He's a very underrated dog."

Bramley now makes yet another feature race final. He was third in the Cranbourne Cup but has also been a finalist in the Sandown Cup, Perth Cup and Troy says a certainty beaten in the Henry Harrison Memorial.

Bramley had not been on the Albion Park track before Thursday night's heat and Troy said the dog would be improved with the run.

"And I expect him to go a lot better in the final next week because he is normally a much better beginner," said Troy.

Bramley has now won 15 of his 38 starts.

Troy will have his litter sister Pillow Torque in the final as well next week.

He admitted Bramley is such a great chaser he was not concerned about starting him in the Gold Cup heat without a look at the track.

Queensland star Dashing Corsair was unlucky not to have qualified for his second successive Gold Cup final. He went into the race underdone and was not brilliant out at the start.

But he was looming up approaching the home turn and certain to qualify but was badly checked and went up in the air. He finished fifth and will go into the final as second reserve.

Macro Meats Group 1 Gold Cup

The Brisbane club has a big night of entertaining racing planned for their first Group 1 Final night for 2011.

Next week's Macro Meats Gold Cup Final will be supported by the Group 3 Flying Amy final which has brought together an outstanding field of chasers. Including Group 1 Winter Carnival Cup winner He Knows Uno, fast heat winner Surfin' Steffi plus the other two heat winners Cawbourne Cody and Swift Warrior. Albion Park has a full bar and Bistro facilities, bookmaker and tote betting it should be a great night for all attending.

The History of the Gold Cup

The Gold Cup was first run at Gabba in 1974 and was known as the Gabba Gold Cup until 1980 when sponsored by SGIO for a year and by Woolworths of another year. It went back to the Gabba Gold Cup until 1988 when the race became the FAI Gold Cup for four years. It changed to the Albion Park Gold Cup when racing transferred there in 1993 and has been sponsored by current sponsor VIP Petfoods since 2002. It has been won by some champion stayers over the year's Dotie Wilson the only dog to win it twice in 75 and 76. Mandarin Girl 77, Picture This 82, National Star 85, Trojan Tears 94, Miss Cruise 95, Boronia Blossom 96, Totally Ablaze 98, Questions 99, Total Denial 2002, 2006 Miss Brook, 2007 Miss Grub, 2008 Chinatown Lad, 2009 Queen Lauryn and last year's winner Nellie Noodles.
