Arsonist Burns

Connections of Arsonist received a big scare during the heats of the Group 1 Hawkins Media Laurels last Sunday when she just managed to hold down a third placing to secure a berth in tonight's Laurels semis. Four days later, Arsonist brought her A-game and scorched the track in 29.60 to progress to next Thursday's \$76,000 final as the runner to beat.

The rising champion fawn bitch (Elite State x Flickering Lady) quickly assumed the lead from the six box with a 5.13 early split and left her rivals standing, displaying the kind of form that won her the Group 2 DDC Launching Pad earlier this year for trainer Heather Collins. Arnalda Bale stuck on well in the run to secure her spot in the final for master trainer Graeme Bate.

The Andrea Dailly trained Cara Bale is sure to provide the testing material in the final after taking out her semi in 29.85, proving too strong for Robert Britton's lightly raced Soul Calibur and early race leader Leprechaun Chloe.

The Britton camp will launch a duel-pronged attack on the final courtesy of Soul Calibur and first semi winner C'est La Vie who continued on from her impressive heat win with an untroubled victory over Geisha Bale for trainer Graeme Bate in a time of 30.12.

Graeme Bate qualified Coco Bale as his third representative in the coveted final when she produced a barnstorming finish to nab one of the series favourites, Galaxy High, right on the line in a solid 29.95 win in the last semi of the evening.

Arsonist and Cara Bale look set to head the betting on the final which will be held in its June timeslot for the last time. Under the recent changes to the AGRA national calendar, the restricted age Laurels Classic for female greyhounds will henceforth be scheduled for late December to coincide with the running of the Silver Chief series at The Meadows.

The final of the \$72,500 Group 1 Hawkins Media Laurels will be run at Sandown Park on Thursday 24 June.

History

Recognized Australia wide as the pinnacle age restricted bitches classic the Laurels was first conducted by the Sandown Club in 1964 when won by Tara Princess. It is a very much sought after Group 1 event with the winner usually acknowledged as a very valuable brood bitch as well as most carve out a successful race career. It has also being proven over the years that most of the finalists are bitches that produce when they go to stud and some have become house hold names after producing some of the superstars of the sport.

The Classic has found some outstanding winners over the years none the least 1965 champ Cheltenham Lass who later in her career was runner up and won a Melbourne Cup as well as runner up in an Australian Cup. Odious who went on to win an Australian Cup in 1976, Carrington Jade won a Melbourne Cup in 1976. Cavalier Queen won the Adelaide Cup in 1977. Paua To Burn won the 2005 Easter Egg and 2004/ 2005 Group 1 Sapphire Crown. Plus two other winners are Hall of Fame superstars Winifred Bale and Sandi's Me Mum. Listed below is the Laurels Classic Honour roll highlighted by so many stars that enjoyed outstanding careers.
