VIC PETERS LOOKS A CLASSIC FINAL

Greyhound fans in Sydney Saturday night enjoyed a smorgasbord of first-class racing with four semi-finals of the Schweppes Vic Peters Classic were conducted at Wentworth Park.

Some outstanding emerging pups took centre stage in the semi-finals of the Group One and \$50,000 awaits the winner of next weeks' time honoured Classic final.

In the opening semi, the Anthony Meredith-trained Mythical Eagle reeled off sections of 5.50s and 13.87s before going onto win in 29.97s, defeating a fast finishing Cipollini by 2³/₄ lengths. Race favourite Bralyn Midge finished a defiant third after botching up the start.

The Wayne Vanderburg-conditioned Isadoll led all the way in the second semi-final, staving off the late challenge of Bolero Bale in 30.28s.

Taking her winning record to seven wins from 14 starts, the daughter of Surf Lorian and Isadora posted sections of 5.41s and 13.93s, suggesting she's a chance of leading Saturday night's final.

Race favourite Push The Paint ran a strong third after finding bother early.

Tracey Hurst's galloper Ringo's Colt charged through late to snatch the third run-off, running 30.36s, defeating Lizard Man into second, with recent SA Derby winner Walter Bale fading for third.

The fourth and final opportunity to qualify was a hotly contested affair, with Brendan Wheeler's Numero Uno Bale coming with his now trademark finish, storming home to win in 30.24s. The second placing of Red Flame gave trainer Wayne Vanderburg two runners in Saturday's final following Isadoll's win earlier in the evening.

Gates open at 5.30 pm, the first race is scheduled for approx. 7.30 and Sky Channel will be providing a live host on the night.

Big run last week coming from well back early to rattle home and make the final behind Mythical Eagle in the fastest of the semi's, 29.97. Hasn't won here yet but drawn okay will need to get away better, place chance looks best.

In good hands and it would not surprise to see him feature in the finish. An each-way prospect he needs some luck at the first turn.

Needs a bit of luck in the early stages from box seven however in race that appears quite even on paper he is a pup on the up and sure to run a forward race.

Local Market for the Schweppes Vic Peters Classic:

What's happening on race night?

A cheque for \$50,000 together with a presentation rug and trophy awaits the winner of this Group 1 event.

All place getters receive a GBOTA Commemorative Medallion as a memento of the occasion.

The final goes as race 8 at 9.48 pm on Saturday's ten race program. Gates open at 5.30 pm with the first race at 7.27 pm. Entry is \$5.50 for adults with children free.

There is also a chance for one lucky patron to win a great prize of a Sydney Harbour Bridge Climb. All patrons will receive a lucky draw entry form to complete and put in the entry barrel near the main tote. The winner will be drawn trackside after the presentation ceremony for the final.

Honour Roll

The Vic Peters Classic is the oldest feature event on the NSW GBOTA's Calendar, this traditional classic, age restricted event (open to greyhounds whelped between July 1 and June 30) was first conducted in 1951 and known as the 'Annual Classic'. It was re-named the Vic Peter's Memorial Classic in 1962 – in honour of and on the passing of Vic Peters, the first Secretary of the Association (1939 to 1961). The word 'memorial' was dropped from the race's title in 2001. The Classic has been won by the likes of Black Top, Shapely Escort, Sammie Sparrow, Woolley Wilson, Tegimi, Alpha Brava, Brother Fox, Worth Doing, Go Wild Teddy, Collision and 2006 winner Cromlah Bale.


