# Bookkeeper adds up a stunning time in his heat of the Group 1 Hume Cup

The Glenn Dainton trained Bookkeeper looks the greyhound to beat in the Group 1 Hume Cup at The Meadows on Melbourne Cup eve after a stunning track record performance in his heat of the Hume Cup.

The talented sprinter come middle distance performer stunned the crowd on Top Gun night leading all the way over the 600 metres in 34.05. The time lower the previous record of 34.07 held by Nellie Noodles and was set in March 2010. Even more impressive was the first sectional sprit of 8.82 which equaled the record set by the mighty Paua To Burn in November 2005.

Bookkeeper maintained a steady five to six length break over the brilliant Proven Impala for almost the entire trip, racing home with a powerful finishing burst in a sensational 12.33 to stamp himself as the greyhound to beat in Monday week's \$75,000-to-thewinner final. Despite drawing box six.

Andrea Dailly goes into the final with two chances after impressive efforts from Lektra Grey (34.41 third best of night) heat win and Easton Bale, who prevailed in driving finish to outgun Evie's Entity in 34.66.

Other heat winners were Born Ali for Rob Britton in 34.37, Alpe D'Huez in 34.60 for Kelly Bravo and Dyna Willow who defeated some well fancied performers for Steve Collins in 34.68.

The Hume Cup had plenty of depth with six heats and it has thrown together an outstanding final of the best middle distance chasers going around at the minute.

Monday week's meeting will also see the running of the Group 3 RSN Silver Bullet, with fields to be released on Wednesday.

Came again in the home straight last week to win in a photo. It was his first win here from six starts on the track. Time very steady 34.66 and he would have to improve to trouble the more fancied finalists. Place chance best if he can be up near the lead.

80 starts 31-11-10 (\$322,195)

Trainer: Joe Borg

By far the best performed middle distance chaser in this final. Has won over 320 thousand in a stella career and loves this circuit with four wins here. Chased home Bookkeeper last week in track record time and will prove hard to beat in the final. Class act.

61 starts 12-8-7 (\$55,377)

Trainer: Andrea Dailly

Better known as a 700 metre chaser but has performed okay at middle distance. Finally broke through for his first win here over the 600 after 10 starts. Handy effort in 34.41 and has been racing well of late in city class. Chance if can stay in touch with the leaders as he mainly races off the speed and comes home hard.

26 starts 9-5-4 (\$52,365)

Trainer: Steve Collins

Had box one last week for a steady win in 34.68 would have to find a fair bit to trouble some of these off that run. In saying that she beat some handy dogs last week. Has been racing very well of late and with some luck in running could feature. Place chance best.

The Hume Cup was initially called the Lord's Mayors Cup and was first run over 675 yards at North Melbourne in 1960, it moved with the club to Olympic Park and in 1964 became the Lord Mayors Trophy and remained a sprint race until 1988. It then became a distance event until 1994 when it was discontinued. The MGRA due to the tremendous support they are given by the Hume City Council resurrected the feature in 2000 calling the race the Hume Cup. In another change to the event in 2011 the race was conducted over 600 metres for the first time and that will remain the distance in the foreseeable future. The race was elevated to Group 1 status in 2012 when prizemoney went to \$75,000 to the winner. Listed below are the past winners.
