Group 1 Double Header Set To Ignite

All eyes will be on Betchoice Gardens next Friday night with the time-honoured Group 1 Newcastle Herald National Derby and Group 1 Forsythes National Futurity set down for decision.

Two quality semi-finals of both events were run and won at Betchoice Gardens on Friday afternoon, with the first four in each run-off cementing a place in their respective finals next week.

Carrying a cool \$75,000 to the winner, both races are steeped in tradition, with the Derby commencing at Wentworth Park back in 1963 with the Futurity kicking off two years later in 1965.

Many past greats lay claim to winning these prestigious Group 1 events and given the quality set to converge on Betchoice Gardens next Friday, this year will be no different.

The box draws for Friday night's finals of the Group 1 Newcastle Herald National Derby and Group 1 Forsythes National Futurity at Betchoice Gardens were conducted Friday night.

The current Derby favourite Mcelle drew favourably in box three. The Jason Mackay greyhound drew the same box in his semi-final last Friday, in which he scored a commanding five length win.

Flavours, the race favourite before the semi-finals, has drawn right alongside Mcelle in box four.

Meanwhile, Midnight Capers chances were done no harm in the Futurity when she drew the coveted red rug for the final.

Another greyhound that has come into calculations is Zara Zulu who was a very impressive winner semi-final winner. Zara Zulu has drawn box five.

It is sure to be a massive night at Betchoice Gardens this Friday, with two cracking, highly contested Group 1 finals programmed to be contested.

The meeting will be run in the night timeslot with plenty of entertainment on offer for patrons attending the meeting.

The National Derby was first run in 1963 and has long been the NCA's Group 1 flagship, at one time was worth \$100,000 to the winner. The club changed its direction a few years ago making the St Ledger better known as the Paws Of Thunder the richer of the two events settling on \$50,000 to the winner for the Derby.
