Hometown Futurity win for Visualise It

Peter Young landed the biggest win of his short training career at Albion Park last night.

The Young trained Visualise It (\$9.30) finished powerfully to win the group 2 Macro Meats Bogie Leigh Queensland Futurity in 30.16. Bill Elson claimed the quinella when Cyndie's Special (\$12.50) finished second and Abby's Fantasy (\$5.60) third.

Young, who also had Visualise It's litter sister Super Vision in the race, gave credit to his parents.

"It's a real family affair, mum and dad assist a lot with the training and the work at home," Peter said.

The three Victorian trained runners in the Futurity never got into the picture from their box draws of five, six and seven.

The jackpot pools on Tattsbet on the night again proved popular. The Albion Park quadrella, with a starting amount of \$11,080, grew to \$74,035. The winners were Size Can Matter, Keybow, Visualise It and Yogi Blue and the dividend was \$337.90.

The First Four on the Futurity final started with a jackpot amount of \$5,000 and the pool went to \$33,347. The dividend for Visualise It, Cyndie's Special, Abby's Fantasy and Oakvale Flyer was \$2,602.60.

After the placed runners the field finished in the following order 4th Oakville Flyer (\$3.80), 5th Oakville Destiny (\$4.30), 6th Tarks Nemesis (\$16.00), 7th Super Vision (\$18.80) and You Can Talk (\$4.90).

Visualize It is a Blue bitch whelped March 2012 by Ivan Brown from Visualization (Surf Lorian x Leataro). She is raced by the Conlon Miller Young Sydnicate and trained by Peter Young of Morayfield in Queensland. Visualize It has won two and finished placed on two occasions from six starts. With the \$40,000 first prize for the Futurity it took her current stake earnings to \$42,135.

The Queensland Futurity is a time honoured flagship event for the Brisbane Greyhound Racing Club first run at the Gabba in 1973 it has been won by some wonderful sprinting bitches' over the years most of which continued to carve out outstanding race careers and later proved their worth as brood bitches.
