Box Draws Complete for the Group 1 Extravaganza at the Meadows

The 2013 version of the Macro Meats Group 1 Temlee over 525 metres – this year worth \$100,000 to the winner – will be one of the most wide open affairs after last Saturday night's box draw.

The field – who has won a combined total of over \$1.6 million - is one of the best assembled, with representation from four states across Australia.

Melbourne Cup placegetter Hurunui Hitman has come up with the coveted red box for trainer Steve McKenna, winning two from two from the draw earlier in his career. He will take on the likes of Glen Gallon, who is lining up in his second Temlee final after finishing third in last year's version. Victory for the son of US sire Flying Stanley would push his prizemoney to over \$570,000.

Group 1 Silver Chief finalists Proven Nitro and Renegade Chief face off for the third time in their illustrious careers, while New South Wales' sole representative Sheikha – a tearaway winner in the Group 1 Paws Of Thunder - has drawn poorly on box five.

Champion chaser Miata – aiming for back-to-back Group 1 Macro Meats Zoom Top - has drawn box four in the 725 metre classic next Saturday night.

The daughter of Bombastic Shiraz and Winsome Bluebird took out last year's version in a race record 42.37, and renews rivalries with fellow National Distance finalists He Knows Uno and Bell Haven.

Thrilling Brat – a visitor from New Zealand who has already tasted Group 1 success at The Meadows in last year's Superstayers final – has drawn well in box seven and comes into the final with five wins from his last six starts.

Queensland chaser Metz Magic has drawn the coveted red box for the fourth consecutive occasion and will be one of the leading fancies in the Group 1 Macro Meats Rookie Rebel over 600 metres.

The son of Bombastic Shiraz and Witheren's Girl is in red-hot form, taking out the Maidment Memorial at Sandown in 34.11 and has winning three of his last five starts. He will take on the likes of Jethro, already a Group 1 winner at The Meadows after a huge win in the Hume Cup back in November.

Female chasers are also very well represented with four live chances including Sandown Cup winner Irma Bale, track specialist Cailyn Bale, Group 2 Queensland Futurity winner Katie Merry and the brilliant Proven Impala, who has the fastest PB among the eight finalists.
