Australia's best to clash in Group 1 Sky Racing TOPGUN

The field for this year's Group 1 Sky Racing Topgun has been released, with the finalists combining for a total of over \$2 million in prizemoney.

The October 25 extravaganza has brought together Australia's best sprinters, all vying for Group 1 glory and the \$150,000 cheque awaiting the victor of Australia's richest invitation-only event.

Leading trainer Darren McDonald will put the polish on two of the Topgun finalists, namely two-time Group 2 winner Awesome Project (box six) and Group 1 Perth Cup winner Keybow (box two). Surprisingly, the Topgun is one feature event that has eluded the Devon Meadows trainer during the race's 21-year history.

New South Wales is represented by two outstanding female sprinters – Chica Destacada and Zipping Willow. Trained by Doreen Drynan, Chica Destacada (box one) brilliantly took out this year's National Sprint Championship, while Zipping Willow (box eight) has tasted Group success on two occasions, and won 13 of her 14 race starts between April and August this year. The speedy Chica Destacada is drawn perfectly to showcase her brilliant turn of foot.

Tasmanian Buckle Up Wes (box five) returns to The Meadows after his amazing 2014 Group 1 Australian Cup victory, and is fresh off two outstanding wins at Launceston in August (29.59 and 29.71). Trainer Tony Brett — who took out this race in 2005 with Black Enforcer — returns to The Meadows with his latest superstar Flash Reality (box four), a winner of the Group 1 Winter Carnival Cup and Group 2 QLD Derby at Albion Park (both in race record time).

Australia's latest Group 1 winner Allen Deed (box seven), is the sole representative for owner Paul Wheeler and reigning Victorian Trainer of the Year Andrea Dailly. The son of Jarvis Bale and Greta Bale is one of the best finishers in the country, powering to his first Group victory last week, taking out the Adelaide Cup in 29.48.

Jeff Britton will be looking to continue his remarkable 2014 season, with Oakvale Destiny (box three) aiming to win her second Group 1 event after her Sapphire Crown success back in May.

Topgun Timeline

- First Topgun run. Victorian champions Worth Backing and Golden Currency defy wet and cold conditions to finish in a dead heat. Revealing finished a further four inches away in third. Worth Backing and Golden Currency split the \$40,000 winner's purse.
- 1994 Topgun held at Olympic Park. Winner's purse increased to \$50,000.
- 1995 Rapid Hiker sets new track record on old Sandown Park track.
- **1996** First place prizemoney increased to \$70,000.
- 1997 Greyhounds from Ireland, the UK and United States compete against Australia's best.
- **1998** Race elevated to Group 2 status.
- **1999** Race elevated to Group 1 status.
- **2000** Prizemoney increased to \$100,000 to the winner.
- **2003** Bombastic Shiraz completes Triple Crown claiming the Shootout, Melbourne Cup and Topgun.
- 2004 Whisky Assassin, drawn favourably in box 8, sets new Sandown Park track record 29.40 seconds.
- **2005** Prizemoney increased to \$125,000 to the winner.
- Race finds a permanent home at the Meadows after both Metro clubs agree to a new feature race structure. Previously the Topgun had alternated between the MGRA and Sandown.
- Superstar winner El Galo is disqualified after returning a positive swab and the race is awarded to Regal Thyme the first reserve, he gained a start in box one following the scratching of the injured Queenslander Knocka Norris.
- Victorian and Australian Greyhound of the year Cindeen Shelby rounded out her outstanding year with an all the way win defeating a classy field in 2009 Topgun.
- Another Victorian and Australian Greyhound of the Year El Grand Senor proved what a great champion he was with an outstanding Top Gun win, he led all the way in 29.83.
- Legendary Victorian Hall of Fame trainer Graeme Bate won one of the few events he hadn't before secured. His extraordinary year continued when Allen Harper took out the Top Gun. He proved too good after finding the early lead. The Wheeler Bate combination not only supplied the winner but runner-up as well with Radley Bale. It was a memorable night for the unstoppable team.
- Rank outsider David Bale (\$31.20) caused one of the biggest boilovers in Group 1 history, running down kennelmate Desalle Bale in the shadows of the post to win the Sky Racing TOPGUN in 29.92.
- West Australian star Dyna Nalin (\$9.00) gave the Wheeler family a historic third consecutive Topgun victory with a brilliant come-from-behind 29.89 win in the Group 1 classic.
