Rails draw makes Royal Sprite race favourite By Ellen Dwyer GBOTA Operations Manager

Wentworth Park specialist Royal Sprite will go into Saturday night's November 9, Group 1 Sportingbet Vic Peters (520m) final as the race favourite after drawing the cherished box one rug.

A sensational list of eight finalists was brought together following four semi-finals at the Glebe circuit on November 2.

The opening semi saw fastest heat qualifier Gimme Fuel start the punters elect, however it was Jason Thompson prepared Whata Good Size which stepped the best winning in 29.82 over Folk Tails and Cawbourne Brodie.

Thompson will be shooting for back to back Vic Peters titles after claiming the event in 2012 with Proven Nitro.

Belfast Johnny for Troy Vella won the second qualifier in impressive fashion, showing strong mid race dash, Belfast Johnny won by $6\frac{1}{2}$ lengths over Royal Sprite, which finished strongly to secure his third Group race final position for the year.

The third semi saw Frosty Vintage atone for her heat run, where she was run down on the line. The 29.90 victory saw the daughter of Frosty Fruits lead from start to finish, ending Avondale Porche's unbeaten run. Avondale Porche held out a late lunge from Living Proof to secure trainer Beau Hedley a spot in Saturday's \$75,000 to the winner final.

In the final qualifier, Evil Punk was the strongest finisher, running down early leader Another Call to stop the clock at 29.70, four lengths clear of Soviet Missile which sees trainer Toby Weekes line up in his first Group 1 Final.

Saturday Sportingbet Vic Peters final shapes as an interesting event given the box draw, with Royal Sprite set to head betting. Saturday's on course events will include a mechanical bull ride from 6pm.


The Vic Peters Classic is the oldest feature event on the NSW GBOTA's Calendar, this traditional classic, age restricted event (open to greyhounds whelped between July 1 and June 30) was first conducted in 1951 and known as the 'Annual Classic'. It was re-named the Vic Peter's Memorial Classic in 1962 – in honour of and on the passing of Vic Peters, the first Secretary of the Association (1939 to 1961). The word 'memorial' was dropped from the race's title in 2001. The Classic has been won by the likes of Black Top, Shapely Escort, Sammie Sparrow, Woolley Wilson, Tegimi, Alpha Brava, Brother Fox, Worth Doing, Go Wild Teddy, Collision and last year's winner Spring Gun.


