Queensland Vs Victoria in Group 1 Winter Cup Final

The G1 Garrards Horse and Hound Winter Cup Final has turned into a Queensland versus Victoria affair after trainers Tony Apap and Anthony Azzopardi secured two finals births each in the heats tonight at Albion Park.

The full field is made up of five Queensland chasers and three Victorian.

Victorian Trainer Anthony Azzopardi has the highly lauded Zambora Brockie and Master Jackpot in the final, coming first and second in separate heats.

Zambora Brockie won his heat (H2) by eight and-a-half lengths to Apap's Vegas Bound, Azzopardi extremely happy with the dogs run on the night.

"It was a good run, he sort of didn't do everything right out of the boxes, he could have come out a bit better but he's done enough to get to the final,"

"I think he ran extraordinarily well, couldn't be any happier really . . . if he can repeat that run I think he can be right in it," said Azzopardi.

Asked about the local dogs in contention, he was quick to name some quality Queensland chasers.

"Outside Pass is definitely the one to beat in the final with local knowledge, Cindy's Magic and Thirty Talks, you know . . . they're all great greyhounds, anyone can win the race, Brockie's not just going to step out and win it, you know what I mean?"

"I'm just proud of the dog, he made it and he's done his best," added Azzopardi.

Another Victorian trainer in the mix is Darren Pattinson whose charge Blazin' Bomber won the first heat in 29.71 sec with Tony Brett's Split Image taking out second.

Azzopardi had the eight and –a-half length win with Zambora Brockie in Heat 2 with Tony Apap's Vegas Bound taking second, with a race time 29.64 seconds.

In the third heat Tony Apap swapped places with Azzopardi to take out the race with Outside Pass, while Azzopardi settled for second with Master Jackpot.

In a great finish to the heats tonight, the final qualifying race was taken out by two top-line Queensland dogs with Thirty Talks (Tony Brett) coming home for the win and the William Elson-trained Cyndie's Magic closing in the final stages for second.

The Group 1 Garrards Horse and Hound Winter Cup will be held on Thursday, July 7 at Albion Park and carries total stakes of \$110,000.

HISTORY

The Winter Carnival Cup has taken on many different forms over the years and has been conducted also at different times during those years. It was first staged at the Gabba in 1978 and sponsored by famous Queensland brewing company Castlemaine XXXX and known as their Trophy, it was run over the testing 558 metre sprint course. It remained the Castlemaine XXXX Trophy right up until 1992 apart from one year in 1987 when it was called the Christmas Trophy. When racing moved to Albion Park in 1993 the race was called the Christmas Stocking for one year and it continued its Group 1 status that the race had gained in 1991 and

maintains currently. The feature dropped back to Group 2 in 1997 and 1998, but returned to Group 1 in 1999. Like many other feature races around Australia in the 90's in was sponsored by the Pet food company Eukanuba from 1994 to 1997 and its subsequent company Nutrience in 1998 and 1999. In the year 2000 the club developed the now successful Winter Carnival at the suggestion of race caller John Brasch and the race became that Carnivals major Group 1 feature the Winter Carnival Cup. It has been won by some champion sprinters over the years and the following is but a few of those stars. Call Me Roscoe 81, Glanzend 82, Acacia Park 84, Dancing Gamble 87, Golden Fox 88, Highly Blessed 90, Iceni Princess 92, Toban Leah 94, Flying Amy 95, Roanokee 96, Wine Glass 97, Winged Runner 99, Mint Mojo 2001, Elite State 2003, 2004 Trewly Special and the only duel winner Glen Gallon in 2012-13.
